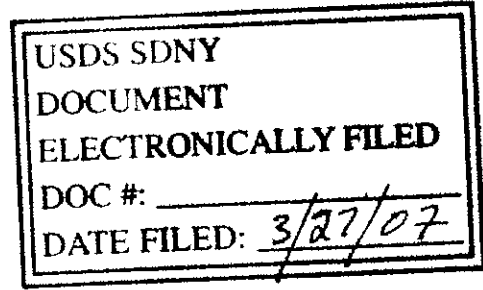

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE FOR
A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Upon the accompanying Declaration of Steve Vaccaro, together with the Complaint; the Memorandum of Law in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction; and the declarations annexed thereto, all submitted by Plaintiffs Five Borough Bicycle Club ("5BBC") and Kenneth T. Jackson ("Jackson," and together with 5BBC, the "Organizer Plaintiffs"); and Plaintiffs Sharon Blythe, Josh Gosciak, Madeline Nelson, Elizabeth Shura, and Luke Son (collectively, the "Individual Plaintiffs," and together with the Organizer Plaintiffs, "Plaintiffs"), it is

ORDERED that defendants the City of New York, Raymond Kelly, James Tuller, Lt. John Doe and Captain Jane Doe (together, "Defendants") show cause before a motion term of this Court, at Room 12D, United States Courthouse, 500 Pearl Street, in the City,

County and State of New York, on March 29, 2007, at 2:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, why a preliminary injunction should not issue pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure granting the following relief pending final disposition of this action:

- a. enjoining Defendants and all those acting in concert or participation with them from enforcing New York City Administrative Code Section 10-110 and Chapter 19 of Title 38 of the Rules of the City of New York against group bicycle rides of fifty people or more, including, but not limited to, (1) requiring group bicycle rides with 50 or more participants to obtain advance approval from the New York City Police Department and designate a "Chief Officer", (2) prohibiting groups of bicyclists with 50 or more participants from riding on Fifth Avenue between 15th and 114th Streets, and (3) prohibiting groups of bicyclists with 50 or more participants from riding on any street or any public place, or material portion thereof, which is ordinarily subject to great congestion or traffic and is chiefly of a business or mercantile character on all days between 9 am and 6:30 pm except on Sundays, loyalty day and holidays;

ORDERED that security in the amount of \$ _____ be posted by Plaintiffs prior to _____, 2007 at _____ .m.; and it is further

ORDERED that personal service of a copy of this order, together with the papers

upon which it is granted, upon Defendants or their counsel on or before 3p .m., *AM*

March 27, 2007, shall be deemed good and sufficient service thereof, and it

is further ORDERED that answering papers be served and filed no later than 4 pm on March 28, 2007.
